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




Would you like a little more comfort? In the glamping accommodation at Camping Veštar, you are close to nature with all the comforts.





Vines are cultivated biodynamically on the estate. Age-old practices such as vinification in amphorae and modern expertise ensure the natural quality of the wines. The wines Amphora Rosso, a Sangiovese, and Amphora Bianco, made from Ribolla Gialla, an old


» At Hvidbjerg Strand Feriepark, a rich breakfast buffet consisting of the best local and seasonal ingredients is available for all guests every day.

- » Camping Čikat has a spice and herb garden from which all guests can help themselves to whatever they feel like cooking. All herbs and spices, such as rosemary, lavender, sage and basil, have name tags.

If you spend your holiday at **Hvidbjerg Strand Feriepark**, you can visit one of the best wellness centres in Denmark. This unique location ensures relaxation at its best. Right on the North Sea, in the middle of the dunes, it offers five saunas, two steam baths and five pools where you can simply relax and unwind.

In addition to the infusion sauna, there is a sauna with an open fire, an infrared sauna and a soft sauna, which combines the benefits of a sauna and a steam bath. Enjoy a classic steam bath with 100% humidity. Or the Rhassoul/herbal steam bath in a warm, tiled room. Here you can pamper yourself with a full body scrub followed by a shower that feels like a tropical rain shower.



Spa and wellness in the Allgäu




Those who bring a little more than just everyday stress with them can receive more comprehensive treatment here. Camping Hopfensee also offers classic Kneipp cures, medical bathing cures and a practice for physical therapy. The cures here are covered by all health insurance companies.

Did you know?

- Camping Čikat in Istria is located in an aerial health resort that has been famous for centuries. Even the Austrian Empress Sissi came to Istria to take a health treatment. Her villa is right next to the campsite.
- The SPA at Caravan Park Sexten has 16 different saunas, some of which are indoors and some outdoors. In the indoor pool, natural rocks are used as pool borders and natural gravel as flooring, bringing the mountain world directly into the pool.
- At Camping Holmernhof Dreiquellenbad, you can enjoy a soak in the indoor pool and whirlpool in healing thermal water from the regional vital spring in Reichersberg.
- At Parco delle Piscine in Tuscany, mineral thermal water feeds the pools.







Admittedly, lazing around on holiday can also make you happy. However, the best thing for us humans is the balance between activity and relaxation. It is therefore important to overcome your inner couch potato and do sport. Regular exercise strengthens the heart muscles. At Sportcamp Woferlgut in Austria, the name says it all.

Sport for everyone. From guided hiking and cycling tours, rafting tours, canyoning and golf weeks to horse riding and go-karting, everything is possible. The facilities include three tennis courts with equipment, a beach volleyball court, a football pitch and the sports, performance and pool centre with a 50-metre indoor swimming pool.

Cyclists can look forward to cycling tours away from motorised roads. One highlight is the 325-kilometre-long Tauern Cycle Path. Advanced racing cyclists will also find challenging tours here, such as the Austria Ironman, Glockner and Pillersee tours. Salzburger Land is ideal for hiking. The hiking programme ranges from easy family hikes to nature trails, panoramic paths and challenging mountain hikes.

Adventurous outdoor enthusiasts can enjoy the longest rafting route in Salzburger Land. Calm passages alternate with raging white water. Experienced rafting guides accompany you safely on action-packed tours in both calm and raging white water.

Canyoning is a mixture of hiking, abseiling, climbing, waterfall jumping and swimming. Together with experienced guides, you follow the water down into the valley through the legendary Kitzlochklamm gorge. You can jump down the two ten-metre-high waterfalls They are the absolute highlight of the tour!

The cross-country ski trail starts directly at **Sportcamp Woferlgut** and is professionally groomed. If you've never been on cross-country skis before, you can learn it here. Trained guest carers show you how it's done and also give advanced skiers plenty of tips. And anyone who wants to hit the slopes can take the ski bus, which stops directly at **Sportcamp Woferlgut**.



On your boards, get set, go! Surfing and kiting at the Wulfener Hals LeadingCamping on Fehmarn.

The Wulfener Hals is located directly on Germany's biggest surf spot. Experts and beginners come from all over to surf and kite here. Due to the predominantly shallow water depth, safe surfing is possible in almost all wind and weather conditions. Perfect for children who want to surf for the first time and surfers who want to improve their skills.

Those who love speed will find fulfilment here. Extremely flat water makes freeriding from a wind force of four a dream. Power jibes and water starts are not an issue here. Professionals and wave freaks will find one of the best wave spots on the island on the open Baltic Sea, which is only separated from the Burger Binnensee by a wide sandy beach. When the wind blows from the south-east, Wulfen is probably the best kitesurfing spot in Germany, which is appreciated by amateur kitesurfers from all over the world.

Fancy learning to surf, kite, wingfoil or catamaran sail? Wulfener Hals is home to one of the leading surf and catamaran schools in Germany. Experienced instructors give courses in surfing, kitesurfing, catamaran sailing and the new trend sport wingfoil. From beginners' to advanced courses and individual lessons:, everyone can learn or improve their sport on the water. Surfing and sailing equipment from leading manufacturers can be hired or purchased in the local surf shop.



The Fehmarn Golf Park, located right next to the Wulfener Hals camping is also a holiday park. The 18-hole course (par 72, 5840 metres) can be played all year round. Depending on form and handicap, a round of 18 holes covers 7-8 kilometres in around four hours. Anyone can play on the 9-hole short course at Wulfener Hals, even if they don't yet have a handicap. Introductory courses for beginners or individual intensive lessons for experts are also organised here.






Football golf at Strandcamping Waging am See.

The new trend sport is not just fun for footballers, but for everyone and at any age. Families and friends have fun playing a match. Depending on the skill and number of players, a round of football golf lasts between 60 and 90 minutes.



The Ardèche is a river in the south of France. On its way, it runs through the Ardèche Gorge, which can be explored either on foot or by canoe on the river. From seven to 31 kilometres, you can enjoy the beauty of wild nature from the water.

Experienced canoeists will love the Ardèche from April to June and from the end of September to November. Thanks to the high-water level, you can look forward to wild rapids. Those who prefer a quieter experience will be happy in the summer months from July to There are spacious gravel banks all along the banks of the Ardèche. You can picnic here and relax in the sun with the best views of the river. The highlight of the tour is the trip through the Pont d'Arc, a natural 60-metre-high arch carved out by the river. The journey through one of the most famous symbols of the Ardèche is a very special experience.

There is a service centre directly on the campsite with offers personal advice on all water sports activities. You can hire canoes and equipment here and start your canoe tour straight away.





Life changes with children. If you could still enjoy a city trip to a chic design hotel as a couple, with children it becomes a source of pure holiday stress. Watch out for the cars, Don't run, Shh! Quiet! and then a tantrum at the breakfast buffet, where flying oatmeal and angry looks collide.

» Camping de Paal in Brabant, Netherlands

Camping de Paal is fully geared towards families with children up to the age of 11. Children can have fun in the water playground, the large indoor playground and in the theatre. Particularly popular: the 40,000m² sand and water playground where children can stir mud and play sand cake.

» Südsee-Camp in the Lüneburg Heath, Germany

At the **Südsee-Camp**, children can experience lots of adventures: speed through the white-water canyon, brave the giant waves in the lagoon or romp around in the large indoor playground in the children's paradise. While mum and dad treat themselves to a few undisturbed hours of wellness. In high season, there is a family-friendly entertainment programme with highlight events such as baking bread on a stick with live music.

» Piani di Clodia on Lake Garda, Italy

At **Piani di Clodia**, seven swimming pools with lots of water slides await enthusiastic water rats. But there is also always something for children to do in the playground, the Mini Club for young children and the Fun Academy for schoolchildren.

» Europacamping Nommerlayen in Luxembourg

This child-friendly site is located in the centre of the **Nommerlayen** Nature Park. Themed walks in the woods and fields, football, the giant slide and the bouncy castle are particularly popular with children. The whole family can have fun in the all-weather swimming pool with its large water playground.

» Feddet Strand Resort in Zealand, Denmark

Feddet Strand Resort is located on a natural peninsula in the Baltic Sea. Here, families can discover nature together and experience the perfect holiday in the huge water park, indoor playground, creative workshops, children's zoo and riding Icelandic horses.

In the evenings, teenagers aged 15 and over meet in the Brasil Club. In high season, teenagers dance here every night from 10 pm to 1.30 am.

Erlebnis Resort Aufenfeld in the Zillertal in Austria

Erlebnis Resort Aufenfeld also offers experiences for demanding teenagers. Exercise takes centre stage here. Teens can let off steam on the covered skating track, the trampoline facility, the fun court and two beach volleyball courts. The large climbing and bouldering hall is particularly popular, where kids can try out the trend sport or improve their technique.







Rasmus, his wife Elke and their two children Mats and Marlene are real camping fans. They have been spending their holidays at LeadingCampings all over Europe for years. Rasmus tells us what he and his family particularly like about camping holidays.

LeadingCampings: Where does your love of camping come from?

All the campsites are different. And we liked them all. This year, we'll be travelling to Lake Garda in Italy in summer to Camping Piani di Clodia and back to the Zugspitz Resort in winter. We are really looking forward to both holidays.

LeadingCampings: Is there a place with which you have particularly fond memories?

Rasmus: Definitely the Zugspitz Resort. It's our favourite place at the moment. The Zugspitz Resort is just so perfect for us that we've been here several times and will go again. We have already spent many wonderful summer holidays here. The Zugspitz Resort has a great location, is a super campsite and always gives us a lot of quality time as a family. I think the children's desire to go to the Zugspitz Resort again and again says it all. And when the children are happy and the parents can just relax, the holiday is just great.

Leading Campings: What do you particularly like about the Zugspitz Resort?

Rasmus: Our children never get bored at the Zugspitz Resort. After breakfast, they rush straight to Didi's children's world and let off steam. While we parents enjoy our coffee in peace. The water worlds are great for all of us in the family. We like to slide, swim and dive together. And we also like to let the children have fun in the water on their own while mum and dad relax a little, read a book or really unwind in the spa area.

In the evening, the children can watch great children's films in the movie theater. Or they can go for a walk in the playground and get to know other children. 

LeadingCampings: Did you also go on excursions?

Rasmus: When we're at the Zugspitz Resort, we always do a lot together. But sometimes we also go off on our own. We like to go on shorter or longer hikes around the Ehrwalder Alm to the Seebensee, to the Hochfeldern Alm, the Almsee Runde or to Didi's moated castle. You can also hike directly from the campsite to the Eibsee or the Gamsalm. Our children also love the Waterfall Adventure Trail in Ehrwald, Moosle's Magic Forest and Moosle's Explorer Trail in Lermoos. We travelled together by boat on the Heiterwanger- Plansee. The summer toboggan run in Biberwier is fun for all of us, as is hurtling down the mountain on the mountain carts in Biberwier. I love the mountains and took part in a guided hike up to the Zugspitze organised by the Zugspitz Resort. My family didn't fancy hiking all the way up. So we all took the Zugspitzbahn railway up to the Zugspitze together and enjoyed the view. The highline 179 is a real highlight. For me, it's the coolest pedestrian suspension bridge ever. It is located south of Reutte in Tyrol. At a height of approx. 114 metres, it runs over the Ehrenberg castle world and connects the Ehrenberg ruins with Fort Claudia. The highline179 is a fantastic experience for anyone without a fear of heights.

LeadingCampings: Do you have any other tips for a holiday at the Zugspitz Resort?

Rasmus: Hiking and swimming gear should definitely be in your luggage. The best Kaiserschmarrn is served at the Hochfeldern Alm. And then there are *our* mountain lakes. One is the beautiful natural mountain lake Seebensee and the other is the Ehrwalder Almsee, just a few minutes' walk below the Ehrwalder Almbahn mountain station.






